

POLICY FOR PLACING CAMPAIGN SIGNS:

1. Small signs (4 square feet or smaller) may be placed in the boulevard with the adjacent property owner or legal resident's permission.
2. Large signs (larger than 4 square feet) have to be off the boulevard (street right-of-way) behind the property line.
3. No signs can be placed on the boulevard of Splitrock Boulevard even with permission because it is a State Highway. All signs have to be behind the street right-of-way on private property.
4. No signs can be placed within 100' from the door of the polling place, (signs may be placed north of the 100' sign, north of City Hall).
5. Small signs can be placed on the boulevard adjacent to city property, (except as noted in number 4) but no signs are allowed inside any city park.
6. Signs cannot be placed no more than 40 days before the election and must be removed within 5 days after the election. Removal is the responsibility of the candidate or committee.
