ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS

UNIFORM CODE ADOPTED

The Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, its most recent edition as published by the International Conference of Buildings Officials and as amended by sections within this Chapter are hereby adopted by the City of Brandon. A printed copy of such code and the amendments shall be kept on file with the Municipal Finance Officer.

DEFINITIONS

Whenever the phrase "building official" occurs in the code adopted by this chapter, the same shall be construed to mean the director of inspections, the City health officer, the director of the minimum housing code, the fire prevention officer, the building official, their respective authorized representatives, or any other City official authorized by the legislative body of this jurisdiction with the enforcement of this code.

When reference is made to any governmental title in the code adopted by this Chapter, the title shall be construed to correspond with the governmental title designated by the laws of the City of Brandon or the State of South Dakota.
