SECTION IN GENERAL

GENERAL PENALTY

Excepting in cases where a different penalty is imposed by this code or by some existing provision of law, every violation of any of the provisions of this Code shall be punished in accordance with the applicable provisions of the law of the State of South Dakota.

CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this 1990 revision, or relating to the subject matter of this revision in general, but not re-enacted as part thereof, excepting as stated in this Chapter, are hereby repealed: provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed as repealing any special ordinances, appropriation ordinances, franchise ordinances, levying ordinances for the issuance of bonds, or other special ordinances of like character; nor shall this revision repeal or modify the provisions of any resolution heretofore adopted by the City of Brandon unless provisions of this revision in effect, either modify, repeal or amend.
