PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Brandon Park Advisory Committee met in regular session at 5:00 p.m. on March 22, 2016 at the Brandon City Council Chambers.

State Trail Grant submittal development status (SECOG) - April 15th deadline.

Parks budget - unused from 2015 - money spent on Stone Ridge land, bridge over Splitrock Creek, trail grant. Any additional could be used towards Aspen Park storm sewer, Stone Ridge playground equipment, upgrade Tallgrass park equipment.

Pool improvements update - 12x12 lockers, basketball hoop.

2016 projects update - will be discussed at the next meeting.

2016 Arbor Day - Devin will make plans.

Items 15-18 will be discussed at the next meeting.
