All activities are located at the K-2 multi-purpose room at the Brandon Elementary School. Recreation announcements and activities will be listed on the Brandon website (www.brandonsd.com). E-mails will be sent to families who have provided an address. There is no fee for this drop-in program and it is not intended as a day care program. All day care children must be accompanied by their provider with a 10:1 ratio.

We are asking children to sign in and out at the door.

All activities are open to persons with disabilities. We encourage all children to actively engage and participate in age-appropriate activities during the summer. The Recreation Dept. will provide accessibility assistance to make physical and social integration successful.

Arts, Crafts & Playground Program

We will have a supervised program of crafts and indoor and outdoor games. Also many other special events will be held at the Brandon Elementary gyms and playground. These activities are open to children of all ages. The gym will be open **Monday through Friday 9:30a.m. - 3:30p.m.** A few of the activities available include: ping pong tables, air hockey, foosball tables, checkers, chess, painting, coloring, marble games, and many other craft and game activities. Some of the outdoor events include kickball, dodgeball, and softball. There will be a supply charge on some crafts. Many new supplies have been added in order to keep this a very popular area. Many special events are also planned.

NO REGISTRATION needed for crafts, games and playground activities. However, we do ask children to sign in and out at the door.

***SUMMER REC ENTRANCE** will be the North Entrance to the tile gym at Brandon Elementary. Use the west (bus) parking lot by the small fenced playground. Follow the sidewalk to where the buildings meet. Enter through the north red door.

Brandon Summer Recreation Bus Trip Schedule Activities and Permission Slip

The Brandon Rec. plans on taking buses to the following places this summer. Open Swim: Daily 1:00-5:00 p.m.; 6:30-9:00 p.m.

- The 50/10 plan will be utilized. The pool will be cleared for ten minutes each hour. These ten minutes can be used by adult swimmers. This gives both swimmers and lifeguards a rest break.
- Daycare groups are welcome, but supervisors are asked to be in the water with the group at a ratio of 10:1.
- Please make reservations for groups larger than 20.

Family Swim: Tues., Thurs., Sat., Sun. 5:00-6:30 p.m.

- Parents/adults must be in the water with any child under age 18.
- Flotation devices are not permitted with the exception of lifejackets.
- Swimsuits with built-in flotation are not permitted.

Lap Swim: Mon., Wed., Fri. 5:00-5:45 p.m.

- Limited to age 15 and older. Admission fee or season pass is required.

Water Aerobics: Mon., Wed., Fri. 5:45-6:30 p.m.

- Limited to age 15 and older. Admission fee or season pass is required.

Wading Pool: Daily 1:00-5:00 p.m.; 6:30-9:00 p.m.

- Available free of charge for children 6 and under in swimwear.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) at all times.
- Child to adult ratio in the wading pool may not exceed 6:1.
- No food, bottles or other breakable items allowed.
- No running, wrestling or water fighting allowed.
- Swimsuits with build-in flotation are not permitted.



Non-Refundable Season Pass:

- Student Single (age 6-18) \$30.00
- Adult Single (age 19-59) \$40.00
- Senior Citizens (60 and over) \$30.00
- Family (w/kids 18 and younger) \$70.00

Non-Refundable Daily Fee:

- Student (age 6-18) \$ 3.00
- Adults (19 and over) \$ 4.00
- Senior Citizens (65 and over) \$ 3.00
- Child (Under 6 w/adult supervision) Free

Weather Policy:

- If lightening or other threatening weather is detected, the pool will be closed for a period of 30 minutes. The 30 minutes begins again with each flash of lightning. Everyone must be removed from the pool area during this time.
- If the pool cannot reopen after 1 hour of closure due to bad weather, the pool will close for the remainder of that session. If possible, it will reopen for the next session.
- Temperatures below or near 65° F at 1:00 p.m.: afternoon session will not be held
- Temperatures below 70° F at 5:00 p.m.: pool will close at 6:30 p.m.
- No refunds will be given due to weather.



General Pool Rules:

- Pool will open May 28 (tentative) with closing date to be announced
- Season patches must be sewn on (No safety pins)
- Child to adult ratio in the main pool should not exceed 10:1
- Inflatable devices, including inflatable swimsuits, are NOT allowed
- Bags or purses are NOT allowed in pool area except those carried by adults
- Food, alcohol, glass or breakable products are NOT allowed in pool area
- Only clean footwear will be allowed in the pool area
- Please be considerate of other swimmers, staff and pool guests
- Pool rules and regulations are made and enforced for swimmer safety, and pool staff is responsible for their enforcement. Staff has the right to establish and enforce rules not specifically written in order to insure swimmer safety
- Anyone failing to comply with pool rules will be asked to leave the pool area
- Any questions regarding actions of pool staff should be directed to the Pool Manager
